Hospital Foundation Exceeds Target for Diagnostic Imaging Campaign

In just eight months the Yarmouth Hospital Foundation succeeded in raising \$504,000 towards the purchase of a new CT Scanner for the Yarmouth Regional Hospital.

The goal of the campaign, called “Looking to A Healthy Future”, was to raise \$500,000. This amount represents the Foundation’s commitment to raise 25% of the \$2million-dollar cost for new diagnostic imaging equipment.

Funding partners came forward with support early in the new year with the Women’s Auxiliary of the Yarmouth Hospital leading the way with a \$100,000 donation. The municipalities of Argyle, Barrington, Clare, Yarmouth, Town of Yarmouth and Town of Clark’s Harbour collectively donated \$250,000 towards the project. In early summer the Canadian Tire Foundation for Families brought the campaign one step closer to success when it donated \$10,000. Businesses, community groups and individuals donated the remainder of funds.

During a recent donor appreciation event, Dr. William Paulick, Chief of Diagnostic Imaging, on behalf of radiologists and staff, expressed thanks to the Foundation and it’s donors for their continuing generosity to the radiology department.

The new CT Scanner is now in use at the Yarmouth Regional Hospital. The public will have an opportunity to learn more about this important diagnostic tool during an open house scheduled to take place in the New Year.
